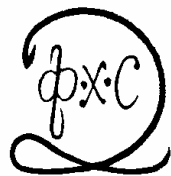

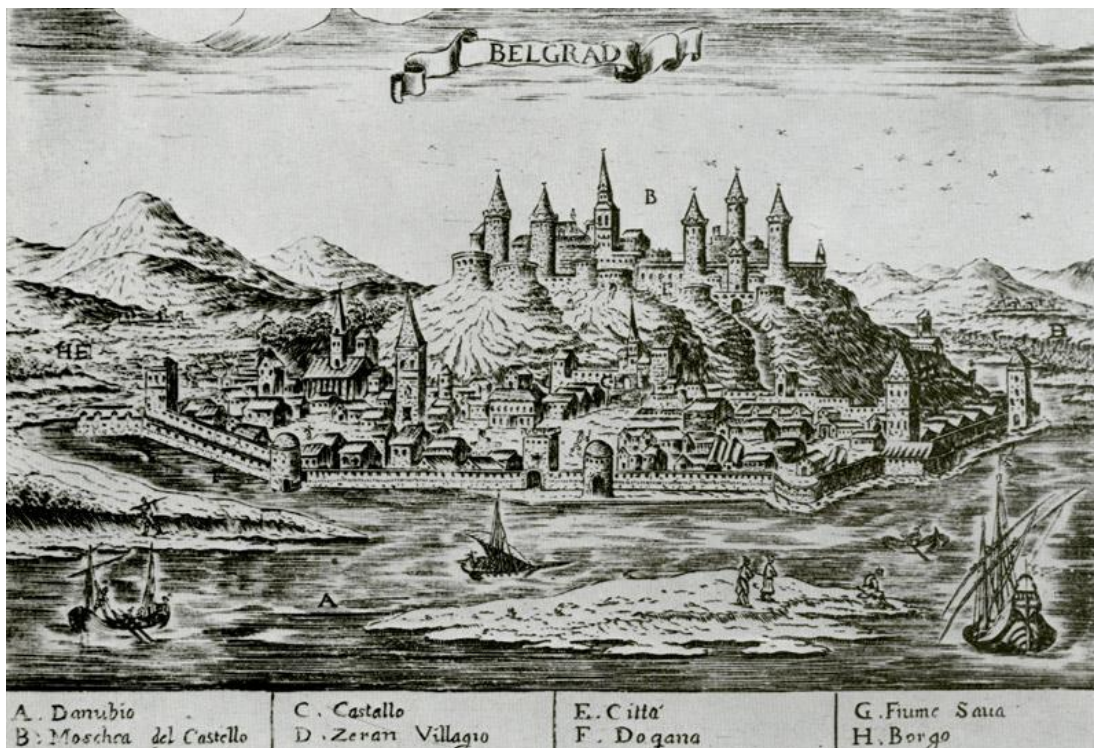

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Contributed papers

The papers will be divided into oral presentation and posters. The Scientific Committee option of deciding on the presentation form, based on the number/type of contribution, but will try to take into account the author's expressed preference.

Paper preparation

The papers should be submitted electronically by e-mail (food_vin@vinca.rs) before June 30, 2016. The authors are limited to no more than three contributions. Invited lectures will be printed in full-length (up to **eight pages**) and the papers of other participants in **strict four-pages**.

Duration of presentation

<i>Section lectures:</i>	35 minutes (30 minutes presentation followed by 5 minutes of discussion)
<i>Oral presentation:</i>	15 minutes (10 minutes presentation followed by 5 minutes of discussion)
<i>Posters:</i>	60 minutes. Poster dimension should be 80 cm wide and 100 cm high

The official language of the Workshop will be English.

All abstracts at the Workshop will be published in the **WORKSHOP PROCEEDINGS**.
